3 Zoom Sessions – 8pm – Sunday, Wednesday, Sunday

Sr. Suzanne Thibault has been presenting youth retreats since 1986. She is best known for the ability to engage students and adults on retreat. The Virtual Retreat format includes live presentations on the Zoom Platform. Each session is 30-45 minutes in length and includes breakout rooms with small group sharing. Each session is followed with discussion and reflection work for the student and sponsor to take a deeper look into the presented material. The reflection work is returned to the presenter before the next zoom session. This Virtual Retreat would be presented as a 5 hour in-person retreat with large group, small group and one-on-one sharing between student and sponsor.

Virtual Parables Retreat (3 Zoom Sessions)

Sunday, Wednesday, Sunday 8:00pm - 8:45pm

This retreat is designed for student and an adult. Adult may be parent, Godparent, Confirmation Sponsor.

Explore the purpose and meaning of the Parables of Jesus. Learn the ancient form of prayer Lectio Divina and open yourself up to hear the voice of God in your prayer and your life.

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Candidate Responsibilities

Attend Zoom Meetings – 3 Meetings: Sunday, Wednesday, Sunday 8:00 pm over the course of one week.

Complete with Sponsor the Process, Integration, and Assessment Materials Return this material to Sr. Suzanne by email.

Sponsor Responsibilities

Attend Zoom Meetings - 3 Meetings on Sunday, Wednesday, (8:00pm) Sunday (7:00pm) Personally, complete the Process, Integration, and Assessment Materials Meet with Candidate to share and discuss this material before the student needs to email the material to Sr. Suzanne before the next Zoom Meeting

Candidate and Sponsor must attend the same Zoom Meeting. If Candidate or Sponsor cannot attend a Zoom Meeting, there will be a scheduled make-up session on the Monday (for the Sunday Zoom) and Thursday (for the Wednesday Zoom) of the same week. Candidate may not progress to the next Zoom Session without returning Assessment Material to Sr. Suzanne. Arrangements for Make Up Sessions are arranged by the candidate directly with Sr. Suzanne Thibault.

Registration Process:

DRE registers parish, (Parent) sends Registration to Bethany Youth Retreat Center

The DRE (Parent) will then receive the Student Registration Packet

DRE sends Registration Form and Zoom Protocol to families

Families return this registration to DRE

DRE mails registration packet to Bethany Youth Retreat Center no later than 2 weeks before retreat begins

Those registered will receive Pre-Retreat Materials one week before retreat begins

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Virtual Retreat Zoom Protocol

- 1 You will need to log onto the Zoom Session between 7:45-8:00 pm due to the large number of participants. Do not share your invite. Those who are registered will be sent one.
- 2 Each computer attendee will enter a waiting room and will wait until you are invited to enter the Zoom Session by the DRE of your parish
- 3 At 8:05 the session will be locked, and no one will not be able to enter.
- 4 Please have your name as the screen name, this helps me tremendously!
- 5 Sign in through the "Chat" with your name, parish, town
 If you are a Sponsor also tell us the student's name you are sponsoring
- 5 You need to mute your speaker and turn your video on during the session.

 If you are not able to turn your video on you need to be in contact with your Parish DRE before the session, so that they will allow you to stay in the session.

 If this has not be arranged ahead of time you will be deleted from the session
- 6 During the Sessions it will be important to see you on the screen
- 7 When breakout rooms are used it will be necessary for all participants to unmute.
